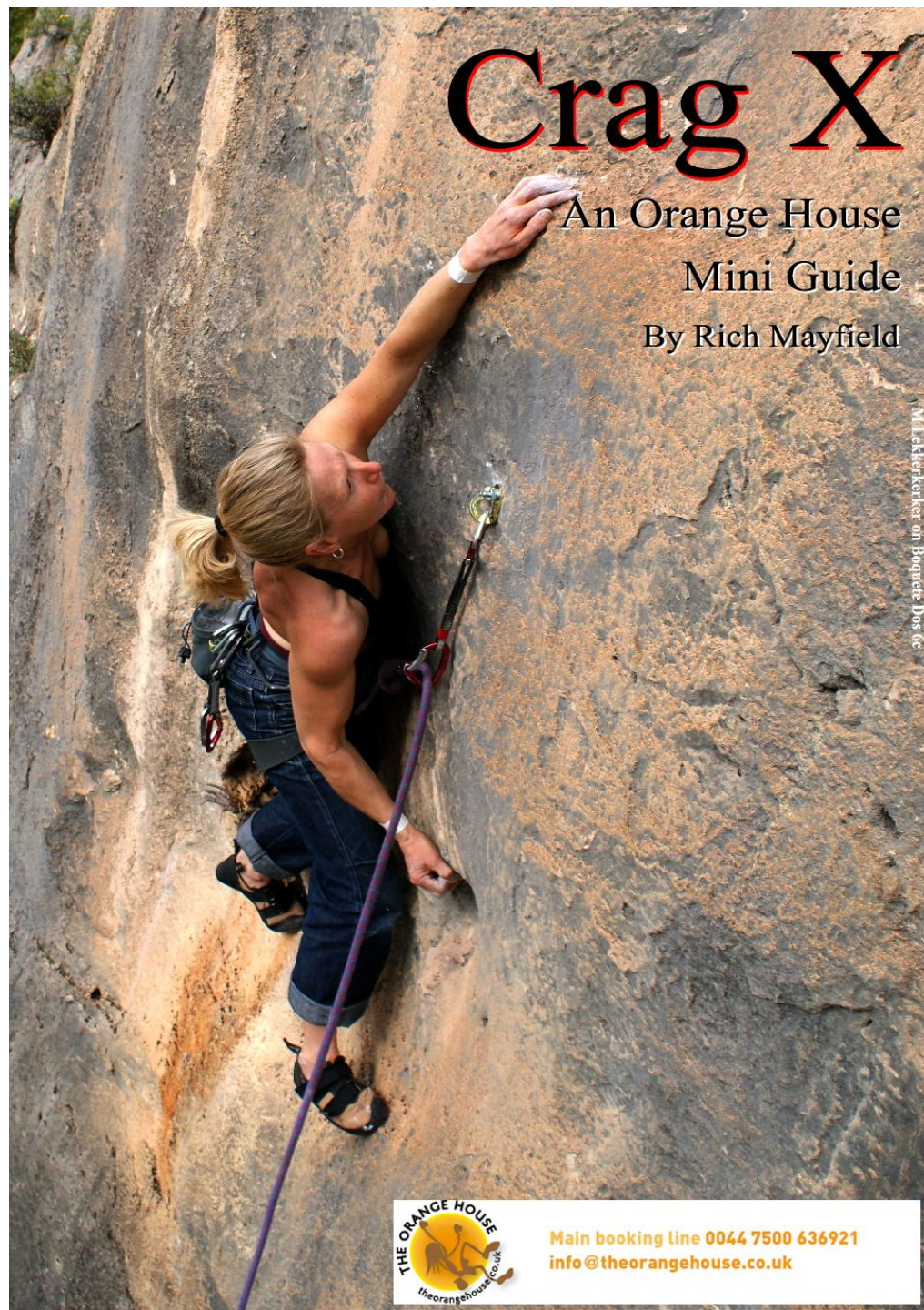
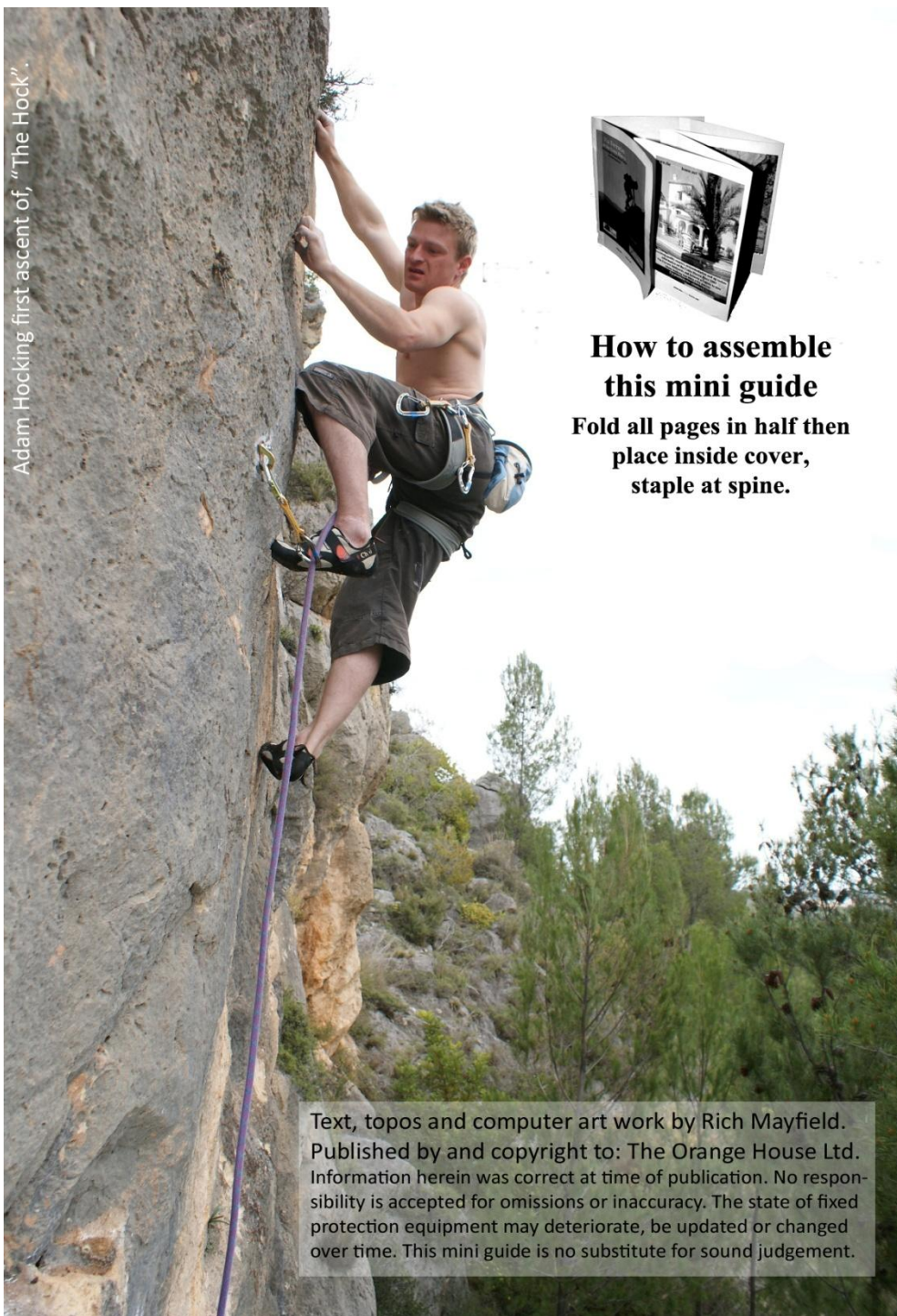

## How to assemble this mini guide

Fold all pages in half then  
place inside cover,  
staple at spine.

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## Approach by car.

On the N332 Benidorm, take the CV70 north over 7 roundabouts at the next two turn left which is still the CV70. Go over the next 5 roundabouts. After 900m, and before a series of sharp bends, a dirt road leads off to the right. Follow this for 800m until a sharp left. Park on the right 200m along here. Be careful not to obstruct the track.

## Approach on foot.

Follow a good path (back on yourself & parallel to the road) for 100m. Watchout for mountain bikers! Until a rough path leads up the hill on the left to the crag.

The Pillar is found first with the main wall situated just behind it.
